

Concept of information activities in connection with the planned implementation of the investment task titled "*Construction of dry small retention reservoir: Malinówka 3 Reservoir on the Malinówka stream under Contract 3A.2 Increase of flood protection in the Serafa river valley*"

Short-term objectives of the information activities:

- to disseminate information and improve the inhabitants' knowledge about the OVFM project, including in particular the reasons and objectives of its implementation;
- to disseminate information and improve the inhabitants' knowledge about the planned construction of the Malinówka 3 reservoir as one of the elements of the cascade of reservoirs planned under the Contract 3A.2;
- to clarify any issues that cause concern to the inhabitants in relation to the planned construction of the Malinówka 3 reservoir;
- to disseminate information and improve the inhabitants' knowledge about the elements already introduced to the project documentation in response to the inhabitants' expectations addressed during meetings held up till now;
- to build up elements of collaboration with the inhabitants.

Long-term objectives of the information activities:

- to build the credibility of PGW WP RZGW in Cracow as an Investor - to inform actively about the progress of works, transparency of the design process, obtainment of administrative decisions and construction of reservoirs under Contract 3A.2;
- to gain the inhabitants' approval for the planned construction of the Malinówka 3 reservoir.

Target group:

inhabitants of the Secesja housing estate

Proposed communication tools:

In 2018 and 2019, at an early stage of investment design, the Consultant and the Client held meetings with representatives of the residents of the Secesja estate in order to clarify any issues of concern.

The estate residents are members of four housing communities. The Consultant and the Investor held talks with representatives of all four communities - at separate meetings.

The expectations of the representatives of individual communities with regard to the design solutions were convergent. The inhabitants' comments and expectations are taken into account in the current construction design.

At present, the most important issue is to reach the largest possible group of the Secession estate inhabitants, not only its representatives.

Activities are planned for this purpose using the following tools and communication channels planned in cooperation with the representatives of the Secesja estate housing communities:

1. Information point

- It is planned to open an information point, where the Consultant's designated employees will be on duty (two persons each time);
- The information point will be located at 55 Modrzewiowa Street in Wieliczka;
- The point will be open for two weeks (scheduled for 13-24 January 2020); the duty time will be from 5.00 p.m. to 7.00 p.m., three times a week (Monday, Wednesday, Friday);
- Information about the opening of the information point will be sent by e-mail to each household by representatives of the housing communities: in addition, information about the opening of the information point will be placed at the staircases;
- the Consultant's experts on duty at the information point will have information materials, including graphical visualisations, framework schedule, basic technical parameters of the investment. In addition, a short 3D presentation on the investment tasks and their benefits will be prepared;
- if there is a larger group of inhabitants at a given time at the information point, the presentation will be provided using multimedia tools (computer, projector):
- visitors to the information point will be requested to sign the attendance list and complete a short information survey.

2. Information leaflets - will contain basic information on contact details, functioning of the information point, investment location and social benefits resulting from the implementation of investment tasks. The leaflets will be prepared and delivered to the inhabitants about 2 weeks before the information point is opened. They will also be available at the information point.

3. Information posters - showing the scope and effects of investment implementation. The posters will be placed at the staircases in showcases and in the information point.

Four dry flood protection reservoirs are planned for construction under the implementation of the investment in question - Malinówka 1, Malinówka 2, Malinówka 3 and Serafa 2 reservoirs, located in Małopolskie Province, the poviát of Cracow and Wieliczka.

Social benefits of building a Dry small retention reservoir: Malinówka 3 Reservoir on the Malinówka stream:

- ✓ Protection of the landslide of the estate adjacent to the reservoir located in the landslide area (support structure including drainage)
- ✓ Flood protection for the back water of the reservoir (correction of the course of the stream and construction of retaining wall)
- ✓ No risk of property value impairment (arrangement of green areas in the immediate vicinity of the Secession estate, protection of adjacent areas against further development)
- ✓ Bringing the existing rainwater outlet from the housing estate outside the reservoir's bowl
- ✓ Ensuring availability of areas within the reservoir bowl for residents (recreational function)
- ✓ Providing an area for playground for children.
- ✓ Limiting tree felling in the reservoir bowl in order to leave shaded areas for residents.
- ✓ Providing a passage for inhabitants to the other side of the Malinówka stream (slope staircase in the stream channel and exits to the reservoir bowl)
