1. INTRODUCTION

Taking into account the planned date of completion of construction works under Contract 2A.2/1 Construction of Szalejów - a dry flood control reservoir on Bystrzyca Dusznicka, carried out under the OVFM Project, it was necessary to extend the validity period of selected administrative decisions in the field of the environment:

- of 26 August 2016 ref. no.: WPN.6400.47.2016.IL on the permit of derogations from prohibitions for specimens of protected plants <u>until 30 June 2023</u>;
- of 26 August 2016 ref. no.: WWPN.6401.268.2016.IL on the authorization of derogations from the prohibitions for specimens of species-protected animals <u>until 30 June 2023.</u>

By 30 June 2023, it is planned to complete the works related to the construction of Szalejów reservoir. Due to the need to modify the content of certain mitigation and monitoring measures indicating the period of validity of permits, it is necessary to amend the current EMP. The developed Annex No. 2 to the EMP for Contract 2A.2/1 contains and orders the necessary additions, which will become the conditions for the execution of the works for the parties to the contract upon acceptance by the World Bank.

2. ENVIRONMENTAL CONDITIONS FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE CONTRACT

The changes made to the content of the EMP do not affect the environmental conditions for the implementation of the investment. The need to change the dates of validity of permits for derogations from prohibitions in relation to specimens covered by the protection of plant and animal species constitutes a fulfilment of formal and legal requirements in connection with the currently adopted deadline for completion of works.

3. MITIGATION AND MONITORING MEASURES

The Contractor shall be obliged to apply all conditions for carrying out the works specified in the appendices to the EMP for Contract 2A.2/1, appropriate to the type of works being carried out: Appendix 1 Plan of mitigation measures, Appendix 2 Plan of monitoring measures.

If such a necessity is found at the stage of carrying out the works, all administrative decisions necessary for the execution of the works shall be obtained by the Contractor.

For the purposes of the execution of the works, the following conditions of the EMP contained in Appendices 1 and 2 shall be modified:

Item 30 Replanting of specimens of 5 protected plant species listed in the decision of the RDOŚ in Wrocław of 26/08/2016

Before the commencement of works in the following area:

in the valley of Bystrzyca Dusznicka (kilometre of the river from km 8+300 to km 12+500), in the area between Szalejów Górny, Szalejów Dolny [in the north and west], Siemków [in the east] and the ridge line separating Szalejów Górny and Szalejów Dolny from Stary Wielisław [in the south],

the following specimens of the following 5 protected plant species should be replanted in the appropriate habitat and outside the reach of the works:

- a) martagon lily *Lilium martagon* up to 50% of 30 specimens growing at 1 position in the above-mentioned area, in places exposed to destruction as a result of the implementation of the Task;
- b) oxlip *Primula elatior* up to 50% of 100 specimens growing at 5 sites in the above-mentioned area, in places exposed to destruction as a result of the implementation of the Task;
- c) snowdrop *Galanthus nivalis* up to 50% of 1,500 specimens growing at 5 sites in the above-mentioned area, in places exposed to destruction as a result of the implementation of the Task;
- d) wild garlic *Allium ursinum* up to 50% of 2000 specimens growing at 6 sites in the above-mentioned area, in places exposed to destruction as a result of the implementation of the Task:
- e) autumn crocus *Colchicum autumnale* up to 50% of 200 specimens growing at 6 sites in the above-mentioned areas, in places exposed to destruction as a result of the Task implementation.

The replanting of these plant species shall be carried out no later than 31 December 2020.

Within no more than 30 days from *the Commencement Date*, the Contractor shall submit for the Engineer's approval *a Quality Assurance Plan* for the replanting of the aforementioned specimens of 5 species of protected plants, agreed with the phytosociologist expert (referred to in item130) and containing, among others, the planned schedule for the implementation of the aforementioned measures and a list of planned plant replanting sites.

Replanting of the above mentioned specimens of 5 protected plant species should be carried out under the supervision of the above mentioned phytosociologist.

Information on the scope of implementation of the above-mentioned conditions should be provided in accordance with the conditions set out in item137.
